

Evangelism and Outreach Committee

Stated Purpose: The Evangelism and Outreach Committee was formed in 2011 to help Lafayette Church reach out to the community around us. Specifically, each week, we contact the visitors who attend Lafayette for the first time. We also reach out to them on an ongoing basis to see if the church can be of assistance to them.

We would like to continue to expand the scope of our actions to actively reach out to those who have not yet found their way to Lafayette. We are excited at the possibility of being a light on the hill for this side of town.

During 2016, Lafayette had twenty-two visitors who provided contact information. Each one of them was contacted by email or postcard. All visitors were greeted warmly on every visit.

We continue to be online with our website, www.FountainChurchTallahssee.org. Updates are made regularly. There was an average of 160 unique visitors per week in 2016. Unique visitors are counted just once when they open the website, no matter how many pages they view while on the website. We hope the website will attract more potential guests, potential members, and our congregation.

The Evangelism and Outreach Committee partnered with the Fellowship Committee to offer a Kirk Night Bible study and meal, led by Pastor Graves. Various volunteers prepared a main dish each week and attendees were encouraged to bring a side dish, if able.
